

**CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 6
CONTRACT OF
Superintendent**

Section 9209, R.S. 1929, and Senate Bill No. 14, 1931 passed by the 56th General Assembly and becoming a law Sept 14, 1931 RS. 1947

This agreement, made and entered into this 15th day of January, 2008, between **Brown, Dianne**, a legally qualified administrator, of the first part, and the Board of Education of Consolidated School District No. 6, County of Jefferson, State of Missouri, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: that the said administrator agrees to perform all duties incumbent upon her as Superintendent and administrator of the public schools within and for said school district for a term of three years commencing on the 1st day of July, 2008, for which services properly rendered and reports correctly made according to law, said Board of Education agrees to issue warrants in favor of the party of the first part upon the treasurer of said school district in accordance with the following terms and consistent with the "Salary Provision" paragraph below:

(a) The annual salary payable to the Superintendent under this agreement for the 2008-09 school year shall be: **One Hundred Ninety Two Thousand Five Hundred Eighty Six Dollars, \$190,586, Longevity/Doc\$ 2,000, Grant Total \$192,586.00.**

(b) The annual salary payable to the Superintendent under this agreement for the 2009-10 school year shall be: **One Hundred Ninety Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Fourteen Dollars, \$196,814.00, Longevity/Doc \$2,000, Grand Total \$198,814.00.**

(c) The annual salary payable to the Superintendent under this agreement for the 2010-11 school year shall be: **Two Hundred Five Thousand Forty Three Dollars, \$203,043.00, Longevity/Doc \$2,000, Grand Total \$205,043.00.**

The salary for the 2008-09 school year shall be an amount equal to 1.5 times the highest salary of the doctorate column of the 2008-09 teachers' salary schedule multiplied by the administrative salary schedule percentages, with an additional five-percent for the doctorate up to a maximum amount of \$2,000.00.

The salary for the 2009-10 school year shall be an amount equal to 1.5 times the highest salary of the doctorate column of the 2009-10 teachers' salary schedule multiplied by the administrative salary schedule percentages, with an additional five-percent for the doctorate up to a maximum amount of \$2,000.00.

The salary for the 2010-2011 school year shall be an amount equal to 1.5 times the highest salary of the doctorate column of the 2010-11 teachers' salary schedule multiplied by the administrative salary schedule percentages, with an additional five-percent for the doctorate up to a maximum amount of \$2,000.00. In addition, the salary

for the 2010-11 school year will be increased by a commitment fee of \$13,000 plus the cost of family health insurance and the cost of a \$200,000 term life insurance policy effective upon execution. This amount will be prepared in each installment on normal pay days at the rate of \$15,000 per year. However, if the Superintendent should voluntarily leave the District prior to the end of the 2011-12 school year, the Superintendent will forfeit the portion of the commitment fee that has been paid at the time of separation plus interest at the legal rate.

2. All other terms contained in the existing Superintendent's Employment Contract referenced above are incorporated herein by reference and remain in full force and effect as if fully set forth herein.

3. If, during the term of this Agreement, it is found that a specific clause of the Agreement is illegal under or violative of federal or state law, the remainder of the Agreement shall remain in force and effect.

Salary shall be payable in equal installments on a bi-weekly basis in 26 equal installments and subject to all deductions required by law.

(d) 12 month contract.

(e) 22 days of vacation.
