


SUPERINTENDENT'S CONTRACT

This agreement, made and entered into this 22th day of April, 2002, between **Alan Hamilton**, a legally qualified public school teacher of the first part, and the Board of Education of the Princeton R-V School, Mercer County, State of Missouri, of the second part.


Witnesseth, that **Alan Hamilton** agrees to perform all duties incumbent upon him as superintendent and administrator of public schools within and for said school district for a term of 2 years, beginning on the 1st day of July, 2002, for which services properly rendered and reports correctly made, according to law, said Board of Education agrees to issue warrants in favor of the party of the first part upon the treasurer of said school district in accordance with the following terms:

- A. The annual salary beginning July 1, 2002, shall be **\$65,000.00** and shall be paid monthly in twelve equal installments in accordance with Board Policy.
- B. The termination date of the existing contract may at the end of any contract year be extended if agreeable to both parties, but at no time shall the remainder of the contract together with any extension exceed two years.
- C. The Board of Education shall provide the superintendent with **transportation cost at .30 per mile plus actual expenses in performance of his official duties during his employment under this contract and shall pay dues to professional organizations that he may join.**
- D. The Board of Education shall devote a portion or all of one meeting, at least annually, to a discussion with the superintendent of an evaluation of his contract.
- E. The superintendent shall receive 10 days vacation annually exclusive of legal holidays and shall be entitled to **13 days sick leave annually.** Also **4 personal days annually** to be transferred to sick leave if any are remaining at the end of the year. Earned sick leave shall be **cumulative to a maximum of 75 days** or as provided by Board policy for professional employees.
- F. The superintendent of schools shall have general supervision, subject to the control of the Board, of the school system including its various departments and physical properties, courses of instruction, discipline and conduct of the schools, text books and studies. Superintendent shall further perform such other and further duties as may be assigned from time to time by the School Board.
- G. The superintendent shall be entitled to **health and dental insurance for the family.**
