

SUPERINTENDENT'S EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

This agreement entered into this 18th day of March 2008, by and between Mike Stevenson, (hereinafter referred to as the Superintendent) and the Board of Education of the Twin Rivers School District No. R-10 County of Butler, State of Missouri (hereinafter referred to as the Board).

Witnesseth:

The Superintendent agrees to serve as superintendent in the public school of said district for the term of **on year commencing on the 1st day of July 2008**; the salary, as agreed will be **\$86,000** annually, subject to change in salary schedule. (Term expires June 30, 2009).

The annual salary for each year shall be paid in equal monthly installments less any deductions required by law and those authorized by the superintendent. In addition, the superintendent will be allowed expenses for meetings and business trips, **mileage at 30 cents per mile.**

For the proper rendering of said services by the superintendent according to the law of the State of Missouri, including the making of all reports and acts required by law to be made, the board agrees to issue warrants upon the treasure in favor of the superintendent for the amount of wages due and payable under this contract.

As a condition to employment by the board, the superintendent agrees to obtain prior to the first day of service hereunder and to have at all times during the term of this contract a valid certificate of license to teach and serve as superintendent in the public schools of the State of Missouri.

The Rules and Regulations of the Board dated July 2007 are hereby incorporated by reference into this agreement as is fully set out herein and both the superintendent and board agree to be bound by them. By executing this contract, the superintendent acknowledges receipt of a copy of these Rules and Regulations of the Board.


